Richards School Online Learning Option

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Enrollment

Students in grades K-8 must follow all enrollment and registration procedures, including those for residency, required for the traditional day program. Registration information can be found on the district website: richardsschool.k12.mo.us or at the front office.

There is a limited enrollment window for online classes. Students should enroll prior to the beginning of the school year. Online classes begin August 22, 2022.

Virtual Platform

Richards will use the LAUNCH Virtual Learning platform. These courses are not taught by Richards teachers. Richards School is the facilitator for enrolling students for online learning and monitoring progress in order to maintain enrollment.

Successful Course Completion & Credit

Students can drop a class as many as 20 days from the start date of the course. As long as the student drops within the first 20 days, they will not receive a grade.

Students must demonstrate satisfactory progress within the first 15 days of enrollment. The district will notify the student/parent that the student will be dropped at 20 days if participation is not sufficient or satisfactory for successful completion. If the student is dropped, they must return to traditional in-person school to avoid truancy.

After 20 days the student and parent **must participate in the online learning course to completion.** K-5 students may return to in-person school at the end of each quarter. 6-8 students may return to in-person school at the end of a semester.

Grades

K-5 students will receive a percentage for completion and proficiency per quarter.
6-8 students will receive a percentage/letter grade for proficiency per semester.

MAP Testing

Students will be required to participate in the Missouri Assessment Program. The state assessment will be given in the spring of each school year.

Equipment Requirements

Students will need a learning device (Chromebook, laptop, etc.) & headphones.
A Chromebook can be provided as a loan from the Richards school if necessary. A signed Chromebook Use Policy will be required for loan.

Chromebook Loan Policy for Richards Online Learning Option

The Richards Chromebook Loan Policy outlines procedures and responsibilities for families to protect the Chromebook investment by the District. Parents/Guardians and students MUST sign and return before a Chromebook can be issued to a student.

Because the Chromebook is an Internet-based device, the student will need Internet access in order to use the web-based applications. At school or elsewhere, students are expected to comply with the Richards Technology Use Agreement.

Responsibilities

As with any District-owned property (ex. textbooks), parents and students will be responsible for returning the Chromebook in good working condition. The student and parent/guardian will be responsible for paying the cost of repairing or replacing the Chromebook/Charger should the device be damaged, lost, or stolen.

Students/Parent/Guardian MUST return district owned Chromebooks to the Richards Technology Coordinator upon completion of Online Learning course. Families will have 5 working days to return to the District.

Any Chromebook and/or charger not returned will be considered stolen property and law enforcement agencies may be notified. Any attempt to alter data or the configuration of a Chromebook will be considered an act of vandalism and subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the student handbook and other applicable school policies.

Chromebooks that are broken, or fail to work properly, must be taken to the Richards Technology Coordinator for repair. Do not take district owned Chromebooks to an outside computer service for any type of repairs or maintenance.

Parents are responsible for the full cost of any repair or replacement of all damage to or loss of the Chromebook and charger. Current cost estimates are as follows: Chromebook - \$200.00, Charger - \$45.00.

General Precautions

No food or drink is allowed next to your Chromebook while it is in use.

Never transport your Chromebook with the power cord plugged in.

Never carry the Chromebook while the screen is open.

Chromebooks should never be left in a car or any unsupervised area.

Do not poke the screen with anything that will mark or scratch the screen surface.
