

## **Open Session Minutes of the Richards R-V School District Board Meeting Held in Board Room on November 14, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Ray Murphy, at 7:00 p.m. All members of the Board were present except: Jacob Deckard and Gerald Smith

A motion was made by Matt Barnes and seconded by Ricky Vonallmen to approve the consent agenda. Vote 5-0

### **Administrative Reports:**

Mr. Premer thanked the Board Members who attended the Athletic Complex ribbon cutting and stated that many compliments about the complex were given at the ribbon cutting. Mr. Premer updated the Board on the progress that Adams' Construction has made and informed them of the three newly poured concrete pads at the Complex and said that we are currently waiting for the ordered bleachers to arrive and be placed. He informed the Board that we are currently waiting on two lamp post from Adams' Construction to be set but feels that everything is looking good. In addition, Mr. Premer discussed the revenue that was brought in from the Richards' Annual School Carnival as well as the first PTO Winter Extravaganza and stated that everyone seemed to be pleased with the turnout at both events.

Dr. Bunn was ecstatic to announce to the Board that Richards R-V School District received an accreditation classification of Accredited with Distinction as a result of the school's Annual Performance Report (APR) conducted by the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE). She informed the Board that the school district earned 100 percent for all standards evaluated by DESE in the APR for the 2016-17 school year. She reported to the Board that the score is based on the district's overall performance in Academic Achievement, Subgroup Achievement, High School Readiness and Attendance. Dr. Bunn expressed her enthusiasm to the Board and stated that she was extremely proud of the district.

Mr. Lansdown informed the Board of the district's upcoming events and stated that everything is in place for the events to run as smoothly as possible. He stated that Richards's students attended the Veteran's Day parade and seemed to enjoy the event. Mr. Lansdown also informed the Board of the upcoming Christmas program times and dates.

A program evaluation by Kim Turner was heard by the board on the Parents as Teachers (P.A.T) Program. Mrs. Turner informed the Board that all children/families who are eligible for P.A.T. services are offered the program in the Richards School District. She also stated that she believes that the P.A.T. Program will continue to help the Richards R-V PK Program recruit students. She stated that several P.A.T. children attended the fall carnival.. Mrs. Turner informed the Board that she would like to see the P.A.T. screening be scheduled sooner this year because she feels that could potentially increase involvement.
